Today, the new grant round opens for journalists and media makers in the Caribbean part of the Kingdom.

Over the past few weeks, Joëlle Terburg and Wensly Francisco traveled across the Caribbean part of the Kingdom for a working visit. On all the islands, they met passionate and committed journalists and creators who are working to strengthen journalism within their communities. We'll be sharing a more extensive recap with you soon. For now, we'd like to let you know that starting today, it is possible to apply for a project grant.

Do you have an idea for a journalistic project that requires more time than the daily news cycle allows? For example, an investigation, documentary, podcast, video series, or written story? You can apply for:

- €7,350 for individual journalists
- €14,700 for collaborations between two or more journalists from the Caribbean part of the Kingdom

- **May 11** – grant round opens
